CHAPTER CXII.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO REIMBURSE MATHIAS SEIBENALER FOR EXPENSES INCURRED BY HIM AS CONTESTANT IN THE CONTESTED ELECTION CASE OF MATHIAS SEIBENALER, CONTESTANT, AND CHARLES A. BAKER, RESPONDENT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated to reimburse Mathias Seibenaler for expenses incurred him as contestant in the contested election case of Mathias Seibenaler, contestant, and Charles A. Baker, respondent, in the house of representatives, the sum of three hundred dollars. Appropriation for contested election expenses.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.

CHAPTER CXIII.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF REIMBURSING CHARLES A. BAKER, IN CONTESTING ELECTION WITH MATHIAS SEIBENALER.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the sum of three hundred dollars, be and the same is hereby appropriated to Charles A. Baker out of any money in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to reimburse him for money expended in the contested election case of Appropriation for contested election expenses.

Mathias Seibenaler against Charles A. Baker, for a seat in the house of representatives for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-six, from the 20th senatorial district, composed of the county of Dakota.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXIV.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE PAYMENT OF INTEREST ON STATE LOANS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriation for state interest.

When act to take effect.

SECTION 1. That the sum of thirty-five thousand dollars, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury belonging to the state interest fund, to be expended in payment of interest on state indebtedness.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Approved March 3, 1876.

CHAPTER CXV.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriation for certain purposes.

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury belonging to the general revenue fund not otherwise appropriated:

1st.—For amount due judges on salaries of eighteen hundred and seventy-five, two thousand five hundred and ninety-six and sixty-four one hundredths dollars (\$2,596.64).

2d.—For amount due engineer, night watchman and fireman, for services in eighteen hundred and seventy-five, one hundred and fifty-eight dollars (\$158).
