CHAPTER XCV.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE AND DISTRIBUTION OF THE ANALYTICAL INDEX TO THE GENERAL AND SPECIAL LAWS OF THIS STATE, COMPLIED BY JOHN C. SHAW, STATE LIBRARIAN, AND J. B. WEST.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the secretary of state be and he is hereby authorized to purchase, for the use of the legislature while in session, and for distribution among the several counties of this state, for the use of the county attorney and other county officers, 1,000 copies of the analytical index of the general and special laws from the first sesson of the territorial legislature up to the present time: complied by John C. Shaw, state librarian, and John B. West, at a cost not exceeding two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50) per volume.

CHAPTER XCVI.

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A CLERKSHIP IN THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S OFFICE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The secretary of state is hereby empowered to employ in his office a clerk, who shall receive for his services one thousand dollars per annum, to be paid out of the state treasury as other clerks of the state department are paid.

When act to take SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from the effect. first day of January, 1876.
