CHAPTER CXXXVII.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF MARY JANE HILL OF CLAY COUNTY, TO MARY MINNIE MIDDAGH, AND TO CONSTITUTE HER THE ADOPTED DAUGHTER AND HEIR AT LAW OF WILLIAM MIDDAGH, OF SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The name of Mary Jane Hill of Clay county, is hereby changed to Mary Minnie Middagh, and she is constituted the adopted daughter and heir at law of William Middagh, of said county, entitled to all the privileges and rights, and subject to all the duties she would be entitled and subject to if she were the lawful child of said William Middagh born in lawful wedlock.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and acceptance in writing by said William Middagh, duly acknowledged, filed and recorded in the office of the register of deeds of said county.

CHAPTER CXXXVIII.

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF MARY C. WEICH TO MARY C. FOLSOM.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The name of Mary C. Weich is hereby changed to that of Mary C. Folsom, and she is hereby constituted a full heir at law of George B. Folsom and Deborah B. Folsom, of Taylor's Falls, Chisago County, Minnesota.

SEC. 2. This act shall not take effect or be in full force until George B. Folsom and his wife, Deborah B. Folsom, make a certificate in writing accepting the provisions of this act, which certificate shall be duly acknowledged and recorded in the office of the register of deeds for the county of Chisago.
