

CHAPTER CCXXIII.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE TRANSCRIBING OF CERTAIN RECORDS FROM THE COUNTY OF DAKOTA TO THE COUNTY OF RAMSEY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the transcribed records of all deeds, mortgages, bonds and other instruments relating to lands or lots now within the Sixth ward of St. Paul, originally recorded in the office of the register of deeds of Dakota county, in this state, are hereby legalized and made valid, and the date of such transcribed records shall relate back and take effect from the dates of said original records in said county of Dakota.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CCXXIV.

AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER CXXXVII OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR, BEING AN ACT FIXING THE SALARIES TO BE PAID TO CERTAIN OFFICERS OF RAMSEY COUNTY THEREIN NAMED.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That chapter CXXXVII of special laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-four, being an act entitled "An act fixing the salaries to be paid to certain officers of Ramsey county therein named," is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
