

CHAPTER CXXVIII.

AN ACT TO REIMBURSE GARDNER B. CHAPIN FOR MONEY ACTUALLY PAID OUT BY HIM FOR MAINTAINING CHARLES D. CHAPIN, AN INSANE PERSON.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the sum of two thousand dollars, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated to reimburse Gardner B. Chapin for money expended and expenses incurred in maintaining Charles D. Chapin an insane person of the state of Minnesota, while in a private Asylum in the state of Massachusetts.

CHAPTER CCXXIX.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-FOUR OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE, RELATING TO A WATER POWER IN POPE COUNTY.

Be enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and fifty-four, of the special laws of 1875, is hereby amended so as to read as follows :

Sec. 1. That for the purpose of raising and maintaining a water power for the propelling of a grist mill on the ditch or canal herein-after mentioned, Joseph Bisek, his heirs or assigns, of Pope county, in said state, is hereby authorized and permitted to connect the waters of Lake Reno, in said county, by means of a ditch or canal across section four, in township one hundred and twenty-seven, of range thirty-eight, in said county, with the waters of the lake covering a part of the west portion of said section ; *Provided, however,* That before said ditch or canal shall be dug, or said water power raised, said Bisek shall first obtain the consent in writing of all persons who will be affected by such ditch or canal, or such water power, or in lieu of such consent, shall take the same proceedings to the same extent and in the like manner as is provided by chapter thirty-one of the general statutes, being chapter twenty-four of Bissell's statutes at large, to assess and ascertain the damages which any person may sustain by reason of the existence of
