AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SIX (126) OF TITLE FIVE (5) OF CHARTER EIGHT (S) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUN-DRED AND SIXTY-SIX (1866), IN RELATION TO CONDITION OF COUNTY TREASURERS' BONDS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section one hundred and twenty-six Amendment to (126) of title five (5) of chapter eight (8) of the General chapter 8 of General States Statutes of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six (1866), utes, page 121. be and the same hereby is amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 126. The county treasurer, before he enters upon the duties of his office, shall take the oath required by law, bonds of county which oath shall be subscribed and certified on the back of ty treasurers, the certificate of his election, and filed and recorded in the performance of office of the register of deeds; and he shall give bond, with duties. two (2) or more sureties, freeholders, to be approved by the board of county commissioners, and in such sum as they direct, payable to the State of Minnesota, conditioned that such person shall faithfully execute the duties of his office, and for the safe keeping and paying over, according to law, of all moneys which come into his hands for State, county, township, school, road, bridge, poor, town, and all other purposes, which bond shall be filed and recorded in the office of register of deeds in said county.

This act shall take effect and be in force from and when act to SEC. 2.

after its passage.
