## CHAPTER 118.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE ACTS OF CERTAIN OFFICERS THEREIN NAMED.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION I. That all acknowledgments to any conveyances or other instruments heretofore taken by any person of cortain offi-previously appointed or elected, and then acting as a notary cers. public, or other officer authorized to take such acknowledgments, be and the same are hereby legalized and made valid for all intents and purposes.

## CHAPTER 119.

REGULATING COSTS AND DISBURSEMENTS IN CERTAIN CIVIL ACTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. When in an action to recover damages for the Tender of commission of a tort, the defendant shall at any time before damages or the trial of such action, tender to the plaintiff a sum of a bar to re money as damages or compensation for such tort, and if such covery of costs, tender be made after the commencement of the action in tender be made after the commencement of the action, in addition to such tender for damages or compensation, he shall also tender the costs and disbursements of the plaintiff then accrued, and the plaintiff in such action shall not recover a greater sum than the amount so tendered; the plaintiff shall recover no costs or disbursements, but shall pay the defendant's costs and disbursements. The fact of such tender having been made shall not be pleaded nor given in evidence to the court or jury.
