CHAPTER 121.

AN ACT TO REPEAL TITLE ONE (1) OF CHAPTER EIGHTY-ONE (81) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF MINNESOTA, REVISION OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-SIX (1866), EXCEPT SECTIONS THREE (3), FOUR (4) NINE (9), ELEVEN (11), FOURTEEN (14), [FIFTEEN (15)] AND SEVENTEEN (17), RELATING TO FORECLOSURE OF MORTGAGES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That title one (1) of chapter eighty-one (81) of the General Laws of Minnesota, Revision of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six (1866), except sections three (3), four (4), nine (9), eleven (11), fourteen (14), fifteen (15) and seventeen (17), be and the same is hereby repealed. *Provided*, that this act shall not affect any proceeding commenced prior to April first (1st), one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877), and all proceedings for foreclosure commenced prior to April one (1), one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877), may be completed and perfected with the same force and effect as prior to the passage of this act. Repeal of law relating to foreclosure by advertisement.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
