

CHAPTER 146.

AN ACT TO SUPPLY WATER FOR THE USE OF THE MINNESOTA STATE REFORM SCHOOL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500), or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys not otherwise appropriated, to procure a supply of water for the use of the Minnesota State Reform School, the same to be expended under the direction of the board of managers of said school.

CHAPTER 147.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR REPAIRING THE STATE NORMAL SCHOOL BUILDING AT MANKATO, AND FURNISHING THE SAME.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500), or so much thereof as may be necessary for repairing the State Normal School building at Mankato, and furnishing the same.
