Third.—For the erection of a blacksmith shop, the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2,000).

Fourth.—For the erection of a stone wall on the north side of the prison grounds, the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000).

Fifth.—For water pipes in enlargement of workshops, the sum of six hundred dollars (\$600).

Sixth.—For the payment of the claim of the late deputy warden for house rent, the sum of two hundred and fifteen dollars (\$215).

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and when act to take effect.

CHAPTER 154.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR / ERECTING AND FURNISHING BUILDINGS FOR THE MINNESOTA INSTITUTE FOR THE DEAF AND DUMB AND BLIND.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the sum of forty thousand dollars (\$40,- Appropriation 000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby ap-for building propriated to be expended in the crection and furnishing of and blind, buildings for the Minnesota institute for the deaf and dumb and blind, the same to be paid upon warrants drawn by "the president and countersigned by the secretary of the board of directors of that institution, and that on presentation of such warrants to the State Auditor, it shall be his duty to draw warrants on the State Treasurer for like amounts, and such money shall be expended by direction of the board of directors of the said institute.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and when act to take effect.
