For services of Pennock Pusey, as secretary of the electoral college of Minnesota for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877), thirty dollars (\$30).

CHAPTER 170.

AN ACT APPROPRIATING MONEYS FOR THE LEGISLATIVE EXPENSES OF THE PRESENT SESSION OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA.
