

CHAPTER 37.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TWO (2) OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND SEVEN (107) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES, RELATING TO GRAND JURIES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section two (2) of chapter one hundred and seven (107) of the general statutes be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows: A grand jury shall be drawn for every term of the district court in each of the organized counties of this State, except that in counties containing less than twelve thousand (12,000) inhabitants, if it shall be made to appear to the judge of said court that there are no matters to be presented to such grand jury not properly cognizable before a justice of the peace, the said judge may in his discretion by order direct that no grand jury be drawn or summoned for such term. The census, State or national, as the case may be, next preceding any such term of said court shall be resorted to in determining the number of inhabitants in any county. *Provided*, that nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to prevent the issuance of a special venire for a grand jury as now provided by law.

CHAPTER 38.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TEN (10) OF CHAPTER FORTY-THREE (43) OF THE LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FIFTY-FOUR (1854), ENTITLED "AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE HAMLINE UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section ten (10) of chapter forty-three (43) of the laws of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four (1854), is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: *Provided*, That the board of trustees shall nominate persons for election by the conference to fill the place of those trustees whose term is about to expire, and to fill vacancies, and the conference shall not elect any person a trustee who has
