## CHAPTER 65.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE (1) OF CHAPTER SIXTY OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUN-DRED AND SEVENTY-SIX (1876), RELATING TO THE TIME OF HOLDING COURT IN THE ELEVENTH (11th) JUDICIAL. DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section one (1) of chapter sixty (60) of the General Laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-

six (1876), be amended so as to read as follows:

forms of court in Clay and Crow Wing counties.

Section 1. That the general terms of the district court in and for the eleventh (11th) judicial district, shall be held in the counties of Clay and Crow Wing at the times hereinafter prescribed, to-wit: In the county of Clay on the first (1st) Tuesday of April, and on the first (1st) Wednesday after the second (2d) Monday in November, in each year. In the county of Crow Wing on the fourth (4th) Tuesday of October in each year.

SEC. 2. All writs, recognizances, and all other papers and proceedings made returnable to the district court of said Clay county, shall be considered and deemed to be returnable to the terms of said court as the same are fixed by this act, and all continuances, appeals, motions, or other proceedings taken or made to or for any term of said court shall be construed to be made or taken to the terms of said court as fixed by

this act.

When act to take effect.

This act shall take effect and be in force from Sec. 3. and after its passage.
