

CHAPTER 106.

AN ACT TO DETACH CERTAIN TERRITORY FROM INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER FOURTEEN (14), OF BLUE EARTH CITY, IN FARIBAULT COUNTY, AND ATTACH THE SAME TO SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER FIFTY-EIGHT (58).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the east-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the north-west quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$), and the east-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the south-west quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of section twenty-two (22), in township one hundred and two (102), north of range twenty-seven (27) west, be and the same is hereby detached from independent school district of Blue Earth City, and attached to school district number fifty-eight (58), in Faribault county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 107.

AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND FOURTEEN (114) OF SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FIVE (1875), RELATING TO BOUNDARIES OF SCHOOL DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter one hundred and fourteen (114) of Special Laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five (1875), being "An act to change the boundaries of certain school districts in the county of Isanti," is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take affect and be in force from and after its passage.
