

CHAPTER 112.

AN ACT TO CREATE A SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT OUT OF CERTAIN TERRITORY IN BLUE EARTH COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That all of the following described lands, lying and being in the county of Blue Earth, to-wit: That the south half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of section twenty-three (23), south half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of section twenty-four (24), section twenty-five (25), section twenty-six (26), section thirty-five (35), and section thirty-six (36), all in township one hundred and nine (109) of range twenty-five (25) west, in the county of Blue Earth, be and the same, and every part of the foregoing territory, is hereby set off and created into and declared to be a special school district under the name and style of "Foster's School District," being number one hundred and thirty-three (133), and as such school district, under the name and style aforesaid, to have and enjoy all powers and rights, and be subject to all the duties of a common school district organized under the general laws of this State.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 113.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE A CONTRACT ENTERED INTO AND EXECUTED BETWEEN THE SCHOOL BOARD OF SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER ONE (1), IN POLK COUNTY, AND MRS. E. H. SHAW.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the contract heretofore made and executed by and between the school board of school district number one (1), in Polk county, and Mrs. E. H. Shaw, be and the same is hereby legalized.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
