## CHAPTER 132.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR OF RAMSEY COUNTY TO ENFORCE THE COLLECTION OF THE DELINQUENT TAXES IN THE SIXTH WARD OF THE CITY OF ST. PAUL, DUE FOR [THE YEAR] ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR (1874), AND PRIOR YEARS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The auditor of Ramsey county is hereby authorized and required, as hereinatter specified, to sell all the real property within the sixth ward of the city of St. Paul, county of Ramsey, upon which taxes are due and delinquent for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four (1874), and prior years, as appears by the certified duplicate of the same received by the auditor of Ramsey county from the auditor of Dakota county. Said sale shall take place at any time the auditor may designate, within six months from and after the passage of this act, and shall in all respects be made in accordance with the statutes of the State of Minnesota, regulating and governing the annual sale of real property delinquent for taxes, and in all respects the existing State law shall apply and be in full force in regard to the application for judgment, judgment, notice of sale, sale, penalty, interest and time of re demption, fully and in all respects whatever, except as to time of sale.

SEC. 2. All money received under and by virtue of the foregoing sale, or the redemption from said sale, due the State of Minnesota, or the county of Dakota, shall be paid over to the county treasurer of Dakota, county as now provided by law, less the cost of the collection thereof. All moneys collected for taxes due for town or special purposes, shall be paid over to the treasurer of the city of St. Paul.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage
