SEC. 7. Said bonds shall be numbered from one(1) up to sixteen (16), if so many are needed, respectively, as they are issued to the parties depositing with the board of supervisors the requisite amount of orders to entitle them to a bond or bonds.

SEC. 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 145.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF HEN-NEPIN COUNTY TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE IMPROVE-MENT OF NAVIGATION ON LAKE MINNETONKA AND ITS TRIBUTARIES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The board of county commissioners of Hennepin county are hereby authorized and empowered to appropriate fourteen hundred dollars (\$1,400) out of any money in the county treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to-wit:

One thousand dollars (\$1,000) for the purpose of straightening and widening six (6) mile creek, in the the town of Minnetrista, from a point at or near a bridge known as six (6) mile creek bridge, to the mouth of said creek, so that it shall be navigable at low water stage for steamboats drawing three and one-half  $(3\frac{1}{2})$ feet of water.

One hundred dollars (\$100) for the purpose of clearing out and making navigable the pass into Halstead bay, in the town of Minnetrista.

Three hundred dollars (\$300) for the further improvement of what is known as the narrows, in the town of Excelsior.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
