

CHAPTER 22.

AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND SECTION ONE (1) OF AN ACT ENTITLED "A BILL FOR AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE MINNESOTA WESTERN EXPRESS COMPANY," APPROVED MAY TWENTY-THREE (23), ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND FIFTY-SEVEN (1857).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of an act entitled "A bill for an act to incorporate the Minnesota Western Express Company," approved May twenty-three (23), one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven (1857), as amended by an act entitled "An act to amend an act entitled 'A bill for an act to incorporate the Minnesota Western Express Company,' approved May twenty-three (23), one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven (1857)," approved March three (3), one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four (1864), and as amended by an act of the present Legislature, changing the name of said corporation to the Northwestern Express Stage and Transportation Company, be and the same is hereby further amended by striking out of said section one (1), as thus amended, the following names, to-wit: Joseph P. Wilson, Francis Baasen, William Read, and Nathaniel R. Brown, and by inserting in place thereof the following names, to-wit: Peter H. Siem, Nehemiah P. Clark, and Cephas W. Carpenter, so that the incorporators under the said act shall be and they hereby are Russell Blakely, John L. Merriam, Peter H. Siem, Nehemiah P. Clark, and Cephas W. Carpenter.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
