SEC. 2. That this act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first (1st) day of April, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877).

CHAPTER 249.

AN ACT REGULATING THE SALARY OF THE COUNTY AUDITOR:
OF THE COUNTY OF ANOKA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That in lieu of the fees, percentages and allowances of whatever kind, which by any law the county auditor of the county of Anoka, in this State, is authorized to charge, receive or collect for any official services rendered by him, the said county auditor shall be paid out of the county treasury of said county, the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per annum, which said salary shall be paid monthly upon the warrant of said county auditor, and he shall receive no other allowance whatever.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and

after its passage.

CHAPTER 250.

AN ACT TO COMPEL THE PROPRIETORS OF THE DAM AT ZUMBRO FALLS TO BUILD A SLUICEWAY OR SLIDE IN SAID DAM.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the owners and proprietors of the dam at Zumbro Falls, .Wabasha county, on the Zumbro river, be and are hereby required, within three months from the passage of this act, to build and thereafter maintain a sluiceway or slide in their
