## CHAPTER 47.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION TWO (2) OF CHAPTER THIRTY-FOUR (34) OF THE SPECIAL SESSION LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-EIGHT (1868), ENTITLED "AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE VILLAGE OF REEDS."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section two (2) of chapter thirty-four (34) of the Special Session Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight (1868), be and the

same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 2. The government of said corporation, and the management of all its municipal concerns, shall be vested in five (5) trustees, one of whom shall be elected by them as president; a clerk, treasurer, marshal, constable, and two justices of the peace, and one The marshal shall be appointed by the board of trusassessor. tees of said village, and may be removed by them at any time. The trustees, treasurer, clerk, assessor, and justices of the peace shall be elected by the qualified electors of said village, and shall each be residents thereof. The trustees and justices of the peace of said village shall hold their office for two (2) years (except at the next election of trustees for said village). Two (2) of the trustees to be elected shall hold their office for one (1) year only, and three (3) for two (2) years—the time that each shall serve to be designated on the ballot Vacancies occurring in any of the offices shall be filled by the board of trustees for the unexpired term. All officers, before entering upon the discharge of their respective offices, shall take and subscribe an oath to faithfully and honestly discharge the duties of their offices: which oath-shall be filed with the clerk of said village. An appeal shall lie from all judgments of the justice of the peace of said village to the district court of said county, in all cases where an appeal is allowed by the general statutes of this State from appeals from justices of the peace, and shall be taken in the same manner as provided for appeals from justices of the peace by the laws of Minnesota.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act,

are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
