JOINT RESOLUTIONS.

NUMBER 1.

A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE STATE TREASURER TO BORROW TEMPORARILY FROM THE GENERAL SCHOOL FUND, TO PAY WARRANTS DRAWN ON THE REVENUE FUND.

Whereas, There are not now sufficient moneys in the State treasury to the credit of the revenue fund for expenses of the Legislature; therefore,

Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the State Treasurer is hereby authorized and empowered to borrow temporarily from the general school fund, for the purpose of paying warrants drawn on the revenue fund, for legislative, executive and judicial expenses, not exceeding fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

A JOINT RESOLUTION TO CONGRESS, OF THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, FOR THE EXTENSION OF POST ROUTE NO. 26,328, TO MARLU AND GLENWOOD, IN SAID STATE.

Resolved, That our Representatives in Congress be requested to use their efforts to secure the extension of post route No. 26,328, to Marlu and Glenwood, in Minnesota.
