#### CHAPTER 112.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500) FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE REPAIR AND PRESERVATION OF THE ORDNANCE AND ORDNANCE STORES OF THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500,) or as much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the repair and preservation of the ordnance and ordnance stores of the State of Minnesota.

SEC. 2. The money hereby appropriated shall be disbursed by the Adjutant General or under his direction, in such manner as he shall deem best to accomplish the purpose hereby intended.

SEC. 3. The money hereby appropriated shall be drawn from the treasury upon the warrant of the Adjutant General.

SEC. [4.] 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

### CHAPTER 113.

### AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO PAY THE CURRENT EXPENSES OF THE STATE PRISON FOR THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY SEVEN (1877).

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That there be hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury, belonging to the state institution funds, not otherwise appropriated, payable to the order of the governor, the sum of forty-five thousand one hundred and eighty-two 89-100 dollars (\$45,182.89.100) to reimburse Governor Pillsbury the moneys advanced by him for the current expenses of the state prison for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877).

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
