CHAPTER 114.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF EXPRESSAGE AND POSTAGE ON BOOKS AND DOCUMENTS SENT TO OTHER STATES IN EXCHANGE FOR SIMILAR BOOKS AND DOCUMENTS OF SUCH STATE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

For expressage.

Section 1. That the sum of three hundred dollars \$300), or so much thereof as may be necessary, be appropriated annually out of any money in the State treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the payment of expressage and postage on books and documents sent to other States, in exchange for similar books and documents of such States.

SEC. 2. That on the presentation by the Secretary of State of a statement of amounts expended by him for the purposes specified in the foregoing section, the State Auditor shall draw a warrant on the State Treasurer for the amount so

expended.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 115.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO JOHN PHELPS, OF HOUSTON COUNTY, TO REIMBURSE HIM FOR EXCESS OF INTEREST PAID IN TO THE STATE TREASURY:

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

To John Phelps. SECTION 1. That the sum of thirty-eight and 95-100 dollars (\$38.95), be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the General School Fund of the State of Minnesota, to reimburse John Phelps for excess of interest on State school lands, paid into the State Treasury.

SEC. 2. That the Auditor of State is hereby authorized to draw his warrant on the State Treasurer, for the above

amount, in favor of said Phelps.

Approved March 8, 1878.

SEC. 3. That this act shall take effect, and be in force from and after its passage.
