CHAPTER 118.

AN ACT FOR SUPPORT OF THE SOLDIERS' ORPHANS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

For soldiers' orphans.

SECTION 1. That the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the State Treasury belonging to the State Institution fund, and not otherwise appropriated, for the maintenance of soldiers' orphans of this State.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.

CHAPTER 119.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR PAYMENT OF THE EXPENSES OF THE PRESENT LEGISLATURE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

For expenses of legislature.

Section 1. That one thousand dollars (\$1,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State treasury belonging to the general revenue fund not otherwise appropriated, for the payment of the expenses of the present Logislature.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect, and be in force from

and after its passage.

CHAPTER 120.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO INDEMNIFY THE COUNTY OF YELLOW MEDICINE FOR EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE CARE AND SUPPORT OF ANDREW H. VIRGEN AND OLE O. OLEBERG.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

To Yellow Medicine county. SECTION 1. That the sum of seven hundred and eighty-four and 70-100 (\$784.70) dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to indemnify the county of Yellow Medicine for expenses incurred in the care and support of Andrew H. Virgen and Ole O.
