## CHAPTER 123.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE PRESENT SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

For the legisla-

Section 1. That in addition to amount appropriated by act approved January seventeen (17), one thousand eight hundered and seventy eight (1878), the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State treasury belonging to the general revenue fund, not otherwise appropriated, for payment of the per diem, mileage and other expenses of the present Legislature.

SEC. 2. This shall take effect and be in force from and

after its passage.
