## CHAPTER 31.

AN ACT TO AMEND SUBDIVISION EIGHTEEN (18) OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND FOURTEEN (114) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVEN-TY-FOUR (1874), ENTITLED "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE SALARIES OF THE OFFICERS OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the eighteenth (18th) sub-division of section one (1) of Chapter one hundred and fourteen (114) of the General Laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four (1874), be amended so as to read as follows:

Eighteenth—For salary of the land clerk, fifteen hundred dollars (\$1500.)

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force  $\cdot$  from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 32.

# AN ACT ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER FIFTY-FIVE (55), OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, FOR THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUN-DRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR, (1874), RELATING TO HIGH-WAYS.

### Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Chapter 55 of general laws of 1874 amended.

Obstruction of highways.

SECTION 1. That section two (2), of chapter fifty-five (55), of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four (1874), be and is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

SEC. 2. Whoever at any time obstructs any of the public highways in this State in any manner with intent to prevent the free use thereof by the public, or whoever shall do, or cause to be done any planting or plowing thereon within the width of one full rod on each side of the center line of said highway shall be subject to a fine of not less than five nor more than twenty-five dollars together with the costs attending such conviction, and on failure to pay such fine and costs may be committed to the county jail there to remain until such fine and costs are paid or until discharged according to
