

## CHAPTER 42.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE (1), OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-ONE (161), OF THE LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN (1877), RELATING TO FISH COMMISSIONERS.

Chapter 161 of general laws of 1877 amended.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That section one (1), of chapter one hundred and sixty-one (161), of the Laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877), is hereby amended by adding the following proviso at the end of said section. Provided that the Fish Commissioners hereafter appointed under the said act, of March five (5), one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four (1874), and of the said act amendatory thereto approved March nine (9), one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five (1875), shall be appointed one (1) from each congressional district of this State.

Relating to appointment of fish commissioners.

SEC. 2. The term of office of the said Fish Commissioners shall be three (3) years from and after their appointment, and the Governor shall nominate such Commissioners immediately after the approval of this act, who shall serve without any compensation direct or indirect.

Term of office.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect, and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 43.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION ONE (1), OF CHAPTER FIFTY-ONE (51), OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF THE YEAR EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN (1877), RELATING TO ROADS.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. Section one (1), of chapter fifty-one (51), of the General Laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877), is hereby amended by inserting next after the words "United States" the following words: "or under contract from the State of Minnesota."

Chapter 51 of general laws of 1877 amended.

Altering or discontinuing or laying out roads.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
