## CHAPTER 147.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY COUNCIL OF SHAKOPEE, TO EXPEND MONEY FOR CERTAIN PTRPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That in addition to the powers already granted to it, the city council of the city of Shakopee, Scott county, Minnesota, has power, and is hereby authorized to appropriate and expend out of the general fund of said city, such sum of money for the improvement of public highways leading to said city, and for

such other proper and legitimate purposes and objects as said city council shall determine to be necessary, for the general welfare and public good of said city of Shakopee; and when necessary, to levy a tax therefor, upon the taxable property of said city, sufficient to pay the same. *Provided*, however, That the amount expended ss herein authorized, shall not exceed in any one year the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

SEC. 2. All moneys appropriated by said city council as in this act provided, shall be expended as directed by said council; and no money shall be expended for labor done upon any of said highways, at a point thereon more than two miles distant from the

limits of said city of Shakopee.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 148.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, OF THE COUNTY OF BLUE EARTH, TO RECEIVE EXTRA COMPENSATION.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. It shall be lawful for the county commissioners, of the county of Blue Earth, to receive pay at the rate of three dollars (\$3.00) per day, for each day they may be actually and necessarily employed in transacting the business of said county, for a number of days, not to exceed ten (10) in any one year, in addition to all other compensation now allowed by law to county commis-
