CHAPTER 164.

AN ACT TO DETACH CERTAIN TERRITORY FROM SCHOOL DIS-TRICT NUMBER THIRTY-NINE (39), IN WATONWAN COUNTY, AND ATTACH THE SAME TO MADELIA INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT IN SAME COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the west half of section twenty-one (21), and the west half of section twenty-eight (28), in township one hundred and seven (107), north of range thirty (30), west, be and the same is hereby detached from school district number thirty-nine (39), in Watonwan county, and attached to Madelia independent school district of same county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 165.

AN ACT TO ENLARGE THE BOUNDARIES OF INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. FOURTEEN (14), IN THE COUNTY OF MEEKER.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SEC. 1. That the following described territory and parcels of land, to-wit: The southwest quarter of the northwest quarter; and the north half of the northwest quarter, and what remains as a fraction of the north half of the northeast quarter of section six (6), in town one hundred and seventeen (117), of range thirty (30), and in the county of McLeod, be and the same is hereby annexed to and made a part of independent school district No. fourteen (14), in the county of Mceker and State of Minnesota.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
