

CHAPTER 177.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE CERTAIN ROADS IN THE TOWN OF EFFINGTON, IN OTTER TAIL COUNTY.

WHEREAS, The chairman of the board of supervisors of the town of Effington, county of Otter Tail, neglected to file certain road petitions within the time prescribed by law, twenty days; therefore,

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That all roads legally surveyed in said town of Effington, by L. W. Rima, be legalized and made valid the same as if the chairman of the board of supervisors had filed the petitions for said roads within the time prescribed by law.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 178.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE CERTAIN ACTS PERFORMED BY O. H. COMFORT AS NOTARY PUBLIC.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the acts of O. H. Comfort done as notary public, during the time intervening between the eighth (8) day of March A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877), and the twenty-fourth (24) day of October A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877), are hereby legalized and declared to be as valid and effectual, as though the said O. H. Comfort had been duly commissioned and qualified as such notary public, during said time.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
