CHAPTER 44.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF WABASHA, AP-PROVED MARCH FIFTH, ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota

SECTION 1. That section two (2) of chapter seven (7) of the charter of the city of Wabasha, approved by the Governor of the State of Minnesota, March fifth (5th), one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine (1869), be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 2. Every qualified voter of the city of Wabasha, under the age of sixty (60) years, shall annually pay a corporation or poll tax of one dollar, which tax shall be paid to the street commissioner of said city on demand, in the month of May in each year, and shall be by him expended upon the highways, streets and alleys of said city.

And in case any person who is liable to pay such poll tax, fails or neglects to pay such tax on demand, every such person, in addition to other remedies for collecting taxes, shall be liable in a civil action in the name of the city of Wabasha, for such tax and costs.

SEC. 3. That section four (4) of chapter eleven (11) of the charter of the city of Wabasha, approved March fifth (5th) one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine (1869), be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 4. All actions brought to recover any penalty or forfeiture under this act, or the ordinances, by-laws or police, or health regulations made in pursuance thereof, shall be brought in the corporate name of the city of Wabasha; and said city is hereby authorized to recover any such penalty of forfeiture in a civil action; or to commence and prosecute a criminal action for the violation of this act, or any ordinance or by-law or regulation made in pursuance thereof.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
