

duty to levy a tax in their respective counties sufficient to meet the amount so reported to them. In such case, after each settlement as now required by law, it shall be the duty of the said County Auditors respectively to pay over to said Crow Wing county the amount collected by virtue of said levy.

Appeals may  
be taken.

SEC. 3. Appeals may be taken from any such award by said Commissioners against any of said counties the same as is now provided by law against the allowance by the Board of County Commissioners of a claim against a county, and such appeals shall be determined in like manner as is provided in section eighty-one (81), eighty-two (82) and eighty-three (83) of chapter eight (8) of the General Statutes of this State.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 104

### AN ACT TO PROTECT THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER FROM INJURY TO NAVIGATION.

*Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

Unlawful to  
throw waste  
into river.

SECTION 1. That it shall not be lawful to cast, throw or empty, or cause, suffer or procure to be cast, thrown or emptied from mills of any kind whatever, any slabs, edgings or timber, sound or unsound, or by falling or throwing any tree into the Mississippi river. *Provided*, Nothing in this bill will prevent persons from depositing mill waste of any kind for the purpose of building or extending wharfs or yard room in any city or town on the Mississippi river.

Penalty.

SEC. 2. That any person, persons or corporations offending against the provisions of this act, shall for each and every such offense, forfeit and pay a penalty not exceeding fifty (50) dollars, besides such further sum as may be found in any action for the recovery of the penalty or penalties, to the extent of any expense in making good the damage incurred or removing to a proper place the things deposited in violation of this act, such penalty to be recoverable in any of the courts in this State having jurisdiction thereof.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after June first (1st) one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine (1879):
