CHAPTER 116.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO REPAIR THE STATE NORMAL SCHOOL BUILDINGS AT WINONA, MANKATO AND SAINT CLOUD AND FURNISHING THE SAME.

 \cdot Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. That the following sums of money or so much thereof as may be necessary be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the State treasury not otherwise appropriated for the following purposes:

First—For repairs upon the normal school building at

Normal school at Mankato.

Normal school at Winonna.

Winona the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500). Second-For repairs upon the normal school building and grounds at Mankato and for furniture, text books and apparatus for said school the sum of three thousand dollars

(\$3,000).

Normal School at St. Cloud.

Third—For repairs upon the normal school building at Saint Cloud and furniture and apparatus for the same the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000). All repairs provided for herein to be let to the lowest responsible bidder.

The several sums hereby appropriated shall be paid on requisitions drawn by the president and countersigned. by the secretary of the State normal school board, and that, on the presentation of such requisitions to the State auditor, it shall be his duty to draw; warrants on the State treasurer for a like amount, such money to be expended under the direction of the normal board as provided by law.

This act shall take effect and be in force from and

after its passage.
