

CHAPTER 125.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR BINDING THE CENSUS RETURNS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the Secretary of State is hereby directed to have the census returns of Minnesota, taken during the years one thousand eight hundred and fifty (1850), one thousand eight hundred and sixty (1860), one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five (1865), one thousand eight hundred and seventy (1870), and *Anno Domini* one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five (1875), now filed in his office, properly assorted and arranged, and bound in a strong and durable manner into volumes. Appropriation.

SEC. 2. The sum of two hundred dollars (\$200) or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated for the purpose above specified.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 126.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500), FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING A SAFE FOR THE SURVEYOR GENERAL OF THE FIRST (1) LUMBER DISTRICT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) or so much thereof as is necessary, be and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of purchasing a safe in which to keep the official records and papers in the office of the surveyor general of the first (1) lumber district of Minnesota. For fire proof safe.

SEC. 2. The surveyor general is hereby authorized to draw said sum on the warrant of the State auditor from the treasury for the aforesaid purpose.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
