

CHAPTER 127.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100) TO PAY M. O. HALL FOR PUBLISHING THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878), IN THE GRANITE FALLS JOURNAL.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100) be and the same is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to pay M. O. Hall for publishing the general laws of the year one thousand eight hundred seventy-eight (1878) in the "Granite Falls Journal."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 128.

AN ACT APPROPRIATING MONEY IN AID OF THE ANTI-DRIVE WELL ASSOCIATION OF THIS STATE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500), or so much thereof as shall be required, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the State not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defending the suits at law, now instituted by James and others for the recovery of alleged royalty on the "Green Patent," for the use of drive-wells in this State.

SEC. 2. The money hereby appropriated shall be paid over by the Treasurer of the State of Minnesota to Horace Thompson, treasurer of the Anti-Drive Well Association of Minnesota, who shall hold the same subject to the orders of the executive committee of said association, countersigned by the president and secretary of the same.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
