CHAPTER 129.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE. MONEY TO REIMBURSE THE COUNTY OF COTTONWOOD FOR EXPENSES IN TAX. SUITS WITH THE WINONA AND ST. PETER RAILROAD COMPANY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) to the county of Cottonwood, to reimburse said county for expenses in tax cases, wherein the Winona and St. Peter railroad company was a party.

SEC. 2. That the State Auditor draw his warrant on the State Treasurer, in favor of the County Treasurer of said Cottonwood county, for the sum above named and appropriated,

and deliver the same to such County Treasurer.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 130.

AN ACT FOR THE RELIEF OF THOMAS HARRIS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of the funds in the State Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of one hundred dollars to reimburse Thomas Harris for money expended under the proviso of section 1 of an act entitled "an act to provide temporary relief and instruction for the indigent blind, and indigent deaf mutes of the State, approved March 4th, A. D. 1863."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and

after its passage.
