CHAPTER 131.

AN ACT TO REIMBURSE THE TOWN OF FISHER'S LANDING IN POLK COUNTY, FOR EXPENSES INCURRED BY SMALL POX.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

To reimburse Fisher's Landing. SECTION 1. That the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400) is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State treasury not otherwise appropriated to the town of Fisher's Landing, in Polk county, for the purpose of reimbursing said town for expenses incurred by small pox cases during the summer of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878).

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and

after its passage.
