

CHAPTER 32.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND FOURTEEN (114) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-FOUR (1874), BEING AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE SALARIES OF THE OFFICERS OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Chapter 114 of
the general
laws of 1874
amended.

SECTION 1. That subdivision twenty-three (23) of section one (1) of chapter one hundred and fourteen (114) of the general laws of one thousand, eight hundred and seventy-four (1874) is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

For salaries of the judges of the supreme court and district courts, forty-nine thousand and five hundred dollars (\$49,500.)

And said section one (1) is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following subdivisions:

29th. For salary of insurance clerk, twelve hundred dollars (\$1,200.)

30th. For salary of the clerk of the Secretary of State, one thousand dollars (\$1,000.)

31st. For services of superintendent and labor on experimental fruit farm, one thousand dollars (\$1,000.)

32d. For salary of the public examiner, thirty-five hundred dollars (\$3,500.)

SEC. 2. That subdivision twelve (12) of said chapter be amended so as to read as follows:

For salary of the engineer, twelve hundred dollars (\$1,200) and for salary of fireman and day laborer, seven hundred and twenty dollars (\$720), and for salary of assistant engineer and night watchman, three hundred dollars (\$300.)

Amendment.

That subdivision twenty-eight (28) of said chapter be amended by striking out all after the word messenger and inserting the words six hundred dollars (\$600) instead thereof.

That subdivision twenty-seven (27) of said chapter is hereby stricken out.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
