

CHAPTER 71.

AN ACT RELATING TO THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT (1878.)

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State is hereby authorized to purchase of the proprietors of the compilation of the Statutes of this State, made by George B. Young, five hundred (500) copies at a price not to exceed six (6) dollars per copy, and the same shall be for the use of the State, and for distribution as now is or may be provided by law, and three thousand (3,000) dollars or as much thereof as may be necessary to pay therefor is hereby appropriated.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of State shall furnish to each of the county officers of each county hereafter organized a copy of said statutes.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 72.

AN ACT TO REPEAL SECTION SEVEN (7) OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND SIX (106) OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN (1877) ENTITLED, "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS TO AID IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF RAILROADS."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section seven (7) of chapter one hundred and six (106) of the General Laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877), entitled "An act to authorize Municipal corporations to aid in the construction of railroads, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 7 of

repealed.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
