

"In addition to the officers enumerated above, there shall be elected one justice of the peace and one constable, who shall hold his office two years and until his successor is elected and qualified, said justice to have the same jurisdiction and to be governed by the same rules and regulations as township justices."

SEC. 2. That section four of chapter forty-nine of the special laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-seven be, and the same is hereby, amended by inserting after the word "resignation" the words "or any other cause."

SEC. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CI.

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION THIRTEEN OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-THREE, OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN, RELATING TO THE CITY OF SHAKOPEE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section thirteen of chapter one hundred and twenty-three of special laws of the year A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 13. When such assessment shall have been confirmed by the city council and the damages set apart, by said council for the payment of the same, it shall be a sufficient condemnation of the land or property ordered to be appropriated.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
