

CHAPTER CVII.

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A NEW SCHOOL DISTRICT IN THE COUNTY OF McLEOD.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the territory situated in the county of McLeod, and bounded and described as follows, to wit: Beginning at the north quarter section corner of section number two on the town line between townships one hundred and fifteen and one hundred and sixteen of range twenty-eight, and running thence southward to the centre of section number eleven in said township one hundred and fifteen; thence westward to the center of section number ten in said township last named; thence southward to the south quarter section corner of said section ten; thence westward to the southwest corner of section number nine in said township one hundred and fifteen; thence northward to the northwest corner of section number four in said last named township; thence eastward to the northeast corner of said section four; thence southward to the east quarter section corner of said section number four; thence eastward to the center of section number three in said township one hundred and fifteen; thence northward to the north quarter section corner of said section number three; thence eastward on said town line to the place of beginning, be, and the said territory hereby is detached from school district number one, the same being an independent school district, and school district number eight, in the said county of McLeod, and the whole thereof erected and established a new school district to be hereafter known as school district number to be determined by county auditor of McLeod county aforesaid.

SEC. 2. Said school district so formed shall organize in all respects as provided by section two of chapter two of chapter seventy-four of the general laws of A. D. eighteen hundred and seventy-seven.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
