

CHAPTER CVIII.

AN ACT CREATING SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER SIXTY-SIX, IN
MEEKER COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That all that certain territory in the town of Ellsworth, Meeker county, Minnesota, to-wit: Lots number one, two, three, four, and five, in section number thirty-three, and the south west quarter and the south half of the north west quarter, and the north west quarter of the north west quarter of section number twenty-seven, and sections number twenty-one, twenty-two, twenty-eight, and fifteen, and the south west quarter and lot number two, in section number ten, all in township number one hundred and eighteen, north of range number thirty, west of the fifth principal meridian, be, and the same is hereby created and constituted a school district to be known as school district number sixty-six, of Meeker county, Minnesota, with all the powers, duties, and privileges, of school districts created under the general laws of this state.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CIX.

AN ACT TO ORGANIZE A NEW SCHOOL DISTRICT IN THE COUNTY
OF LE SUEUR.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That so much of the county of Le Sueur as is embraced in the following territory as follows, viz: The whole of section twenty-eight, the whole of section twenty-nine, east half of section thirty, northeast quarter of section thirty-one, north half of section thirty-two, north half of section thirty-three, in Le Sueur county, township of Lexington number one hundred and eleven, range twenty-four, be and the same is hereby constituted as a school district for all common school purposes whatsoever, and be subject to the common school laws of this state, and to be known and designated as district number thirteen of Le Sueur county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
