## CHAPTER CXII.

AN ACT ENTITLED AN ACT TO CREATE SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER ONE OF THE COUNTY OF SHERBURNE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. All that part of Sherburne county, in the state of Minnesota, bounded by a line commencing at the center of section number twenty, of township number thirty-four, of range number twenty-nine, and running thence, north through section numbered seventeen, eight, and five, to the north line of said township, from thence west to the northwest corner of said section number five, from thence south to the southwest corner of said section number five, from thence west to the northwest corner of section number twelve, of township number thirty-four, of range number thirty, from thence south to the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of section number twenty-four, and from thence east through said section number twenty-four, and sections nineteen and twenty, in township thirty-four, range twenty-nine aforesaid to the place of beginning, be, and is hereby created a special school district, to be known and designated as special school district number one, of Sherburne county.

SEC. 2. Said district shall be organized, regulated and governed in the manner specified in chapter seventy-four of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven for the organization, regulation and government of common school districts.

SEC. 3. All provisions of said chapter seventy-four applicable to common school districts, shall be applicable to said special district and said special district shall be entitled to all privileges and shall be under the same liabilities as fully as if formed under said chapter.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage, and is hereby declared to be a general act.
