

CHAPTER CXX.

AN ACT RELATING TO THE NORTHFIELD VILLAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT ESTABLISHED BY CHAPTER SIXTEEN OF THE SPECIAL LAWS OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY-FOUR.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Section one of said chapter is hereby amended by striking out the word, "village" from the style of said act.

SEC. 2. The officers of the said district shall hereafter be elected on the first Saturday of October in each year, and all election of officers heretofore had on said day are hereby legalized.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXXI.

AN ACT TO DEATCH CERTAIN TERRITORY THEREIN NAMED FROM SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER FIFTEEN, AND ATTACH THE SAME TO SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER NINE ALL IN MEEKER COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the following described territory, viz: The east half of the southeast quarter, and the northeast quarter of section number six, all of section number seven, all of section number eighteen, and the east half of the northeast quarter, and the east half of the southeast quarter of section nineteen, all in township one hundred and nineteen of range number thirty west, be and the same is hereby detached from school district number fifteen and attached to school district number nine—all in Meeker county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
