## CHAPTER CXCVI.

### AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CLERK OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF LE SUEUR COUNTY TO PROPERLY ARRANGE THE PAPERS IN HIS OFFICE RELATING TO ACTIONS AND PROCEEDINGS HAD IN SAID COURT.

# Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the clerk of the district court of the county of Le Sueur be and he is hereby authorized and empowered, at the expense of said county, and under the direction and supervision of the judge of said court, to properly arrange and attach together all papers in his office relating to any and all actions and proceedings numbering the several actions or proceedings, in the order in which they were commenced in said court, as near as possible, and to enter in the register of actions in his office under the number and title of each action or proceeding all the papers relating to each action or proceeding.

SEC. 2. That the said clerk shall receive such compensation for such services as the judge of said court shall fix therefor.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

#### CHAPTER CXCVII.

#### AN ACT AUTHORIZING BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LE SUEUR COUNTY TO FIX SALARY OF THE AUDITOR OF SAID COUNTY AND THE AUDITOR'S CLERKS.

#### Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the board of county commissioners of the county of Le Sueur be and they are hereby empowered and shall have authority, at any regular meeting of said board, by a majority vote, to fix and determine the amount of salary or compensation that the auditor of said county shall receive; also the amount of salary or compensation which said auditor shall pay to any or all clerks by him employed in said auditor's office, and that the amount so determined or fixed by said board of county commissioners shall be the sum to be paid to said auditor and his clerks. *Provided* that the total amount or aggregate of all sums of money to be paid to said auditor and his clerks shall not exceed the sum of two thousand dollars.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
