CHAPTER CCXI.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF ST. PAUL TO AID IN THE IM-PROVEMENT OF ROADS LEADING INTO THE CITY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The common council of the city of St. Paul is hereby empowered by a three-fourths vote of all the members elect at any time during the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty, to issue the bonds of said city, or to appropriate money either from the general fund or the local improvement fund of said city, to an amount not to exceed ten thousand dollars, to be expended by the board of public works, under the direction of the common council, outside of the city limits, upon such roads leading into the city of St. Paul, as the common council may deem proper.

SEC. 2. If the common council shall determine to issue said bonds, they shall bear interest at the rate of seven per cent. per annum, and shall be payable at such time as the common council may determine at the financial agency of the city of St. Paul in the city of New York.

SEC. 3. If the common council shall determine not to issue said bonds, but to appropriate said sum of ten thousand dollars, or less, out of either of the funds before named, it then shall be the duty of the common council to include in the next general levy of taxes for city purposes, a sufficient number of mills on the dollar of the assessed value of all the real and personal property in the city of St. Paul, to replace in the city treasury the sum advanced and appropriated aforesaid.

SEC. 4. This act to be in force from and after its passage. Approved February 14, 1879.
