

CHAPTER CCXVII.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FAIRMONT, IN MARTIN COUNTY, TO HOLD ELECTIONS AND TRANSACT BUSINESS OF SAID TOWN IN THE VILLAGE OF FAIRMONT IN SAID COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the legal voters of the township of Fairmont, in Martin county, are hereby authorized to hold their town meetings and general elections and transact their town business in the village of Fairmont in said county, in some suitable place in said village, to be selected by the supervisors of said town, or a majority thereof; *Provided*, that the question of determining where the said elections of said town shall be held and the business of said town transacted after the regular town meeting in said town in March, eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, shall be submitted to the legal voters of said town at said town meeting in March, eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, immediately after the time for the election of overseers of highways, and shall be determined in the same manner that said officers are elected; and the place selected by a majority of the legal voters assembled as aforesaid, shall thereafter be the place for the purpose of elections and business aforesaid, subject to a change thereof in the manner aforesaid, at any subsequent town meeting of said township.

SEC. 2. All notices of election and meetings of town boards shall be given under this act as are now required to be given by law in cases of such meetings.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
