

SEC. 2. Any person having an unsettled claim for damages against said county or any town in said county by reason of the laying out and opening of said roads or any of them, shall at any regular meeting before the regular meetings of the commissioners of said county or the supervisors of any town in said county in the month of July, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty present such claim in writing to the auditor of said county or the clerk of such town who shall lay the same before said commissioners or supervisors, as the case may be, for their action thereon, and if any person having such claim shall fail to present it as aforesaid, he shall forever be debarred from further redress for said damages.

*Provided*, That nothing in this act shall be so construed as to revive any right or claim for damages now barred by law or the statutes of limitations, and provided further that any party may appeal from the decision of such supervisors or commissioners as is now provided by law for appeals from awards or damages in laying out county or town roads.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER CCXXXI.

### AN ACT TO LEGALIZE CERTAIN ROADS AND HIGHWAYS IN THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That all roads and highways laid out and opened prior to the year A. D. eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, in the county of Douglas and state of Minnesota, by the commissioners of said county or the supervisors of any town in said county, are hereby declared to be public roads or highways, and confirmed and established as such, whether the same have been lawfully laid out, established and opened or not, provided that public work or public money has been expended upon such road or roads, or any part thereof.

SEC. 2. Any person having an unsettled claim for damages against said county or any town therein, by reason of the laying out and opening of said roads or any of them, shall at any regular meeting prior to the regular meeting of the commissioners of said county or the supervisors of any town therein, in the month of July, A. D. eighteen hundred and eighty, present such claim in writing to the auditor of said county or the clerk of such town,

who shall lay the same before said commissioners or supervisors, as the case may be, for their action thereon; and if any person having such claim shall fail to present it as aforesaid, he shall forever be debarred from farther redress for said damages.

*Provided*, That nothing in this act shall be so construed as to revive any right or claim for damages now barred by law or the statute of limitation, and *provided*, further, that any party may appeal from the decision of such supervisors or commissioners as is now provided by law for appeals from awards or damages in laying out county and town roads.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER CCXXXII.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE CORPORATE ORGANIZATION OF CERTAIN RELIGIOUS SOCIETIES, AND PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF TRUSTEES AND OFFICERS THEREOF.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the several religious societies hereinafter named that have adopted certificates of incorporation under and by virtue of the provisions of chapter thirty-four, of the general statutes relating to the incorporation of religious societies, and of the acts amendatory thereof, which said societies are named and located as follows, to-wit:

Church of St. John the Evangelist, New Canada, Ramsey county, Minnesota.

Holy Trinity Church of New Ulm, Brown county, Minnesota.

Saint George's Church of West Newton, Nicollet county, Minnesota.

Saint John's Church of Brownsville, Dakota county, Minnesota.

Saint Joseph's Church of Lakeville, Dakota county, Minnesota.

Saint Mary's Church of New Trier, Dakota county, Minnesota.

Saint Patrick's Church of Inver Grove, State of Minnesota.

Saint Peter's Church, Mendota, Minnesota.

All Saint's Church, Lakeville, Dakota county, Minnesota.

Saint Joseph's Church of Red Wing, Minnesota.

The Sacred Heart Church of Faribault, Rice county, Minnesota.

Saint Anthony's Church, Minneapolis, Minnesota.

The Church of Our Lady of Lourdes, of St. Anthony, Minnesota.

The Church of Saints Peter and Paul, of Medina town, Minnesota.
