## CHAPTER CCXXXVII.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE SCHOOL TAX OF INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER ONE IN THE COUNTY OF LE SUEUR FOR THE YEAR EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-EIGHT, AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the action of the board of education of independent school district number one; of Le Sueur county, had on the fifth day of October, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, levying a tax of thirty-nine hundred dollars on the taxable property of said district for school purposes for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, and the action of the county auditor of said county extending the same upon the tax duplicate of said county for the year eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, be and the same are hereby legalized and made valid in all respects.

Sec. 2. The said board of education is hereby authorized and empowered to use the moneys raised from said tax in paying the indebtedness of said district and in supporting the schools thereof,

in such manner as they see fit.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER CCXXXVIII.

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE ACT OF SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER SIXTY-FOUR, RENVILLE COUNTY, MINNESOTA, IN VOTING TO ISSUE ITS BONDS TO BUILD A SCHOOL HOUSE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the act of school district number sixty-four, Renville county, Minnesota, in voting to issue its bonds in the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars, at a special meeting held in said district, December seventh, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight for the purpose of building and furnishing a school house, is hereby legalized and made valid, and said school district is hereby authorized to issue said bonds in conformity to the vote of said district at the special school meeting aforesaid.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.
