

## CHAPTER CCXXXIX.

AN ACT TO CONFIRM AND LEGALIZE THE ACTS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWN OF OSAKIS, IN THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS AND STATE OF MINNESOTA, IN OBTAINING AND CONVEYING THE RIGHT OF WAY FOR THE SAINT PAUL AND PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY THROUGH THE SAID TOWN.

WHEREAS, The board of supervisors of the town of Osakis in the county of Douglas and state of Minnesota did in the year A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight purchase and take deeds from private parties for the right of way and depot grounds for the St. Paul and Pacific Railroad Company through the said town of Osakis and

WHEREAS, The said board of Supervisors of the said town of Osakis did by their certain warranty deed, dated the 10th day of August, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight, convey to the said St. Paul and Pacific Railroad Company all of said lands so conveyed to them for said right of way and depot grounds therefore.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That all the acts of the board of supervisors of the town of Osakis in the county of Douglas and state of Minnesota in purchasing and taking title to the lands for right of way and depot grounds for the St. Paul and Pacific Railroad Company through the said town and also the transfer by the said board of supervisors to the said company of the said right of way and depot grounds are in all respects legalized, approved, ratified, confirmed and made valid.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
